The Krishnashray Gurukul project aims to mentor underprivileged youth to become socially conscious leaders, focusing on the 3Ps: Power, Purpose, and Platform. 

K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University, established in 2023 and located in Mathura, Uttar Pradesh, is a UGC-approved private university offering a wide range of undergraduate, postgraduate, diploma, and doctoral programs across various disciplines, including Medical Sciences, Engineering, Management, Pharmacy, Agriculture, Liberal Arts, and Education. The university is committed to providing quality education and fostering holistic development through innovative teaching, research, and community engagement. This Non-Financial MoU is drawn up and agreed upon to establish cooperation between the above-mentioned Parties to promote skill development and youth empowerment in rural communities.

I. Background and Purpose of MOU

- a. Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI has been working towards empowering rural youth through skill-based training, mentoring, and placement support. Recognizing the existing skill gap and the need to transform India's demographic dividend into a strength, Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI and K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University aim to collaborate to create meaningful interventions and long-term sustainable development in students' lives.



- b. K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University is dedicated to preparing students for successful careers and responsible citizenship. With a strong academic foundation and student-centric approach, the University sees this MoU as an opportunity to offer its students additional pathways for employability and growth.

II. Scope of Work

• Faculty Exchange and Resource Sharing

Both Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI and K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University will collaborate for faculty exchange and resource sharing. Subject experts from both institutions will conduct training sessions, workshops, and academic engagements at each other's campuses, as mutually agreed.

• Exposure Visits

Students from Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI will be provided academic exposure through guided visits to K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University. Similarly, K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University students will visit Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI to gain insights into ground-level community development and skill training models.

• Upskilling and Higher Education Opportunities

K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University will offer pathways for higher education and certification to eligible students of Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI, supporting their academic and professional advancement.

• Internship Opportunities

K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University students will have the opportunity to undertake internships at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI by enrolling in suitable training modules and participating in community-based fieldwork and project support.

• Free Medical Camps in Mutual Collaboration

Both parties will jointly organize free medical camps in underserved communities. K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University will support with its health sciences and paramedical departments, while Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI will support with mobilization and on-ground facilitation.

• Career Counseling Seminars

Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI will conduct career counseling seminars at K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University to guide students on skill-based career options. Likewise, K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University officials will conduct awareness seminars at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI about academic programs and higher study opportunities.

• Collaboration on the Better Wheat Initiative

Krishnashray Foundation's Better Wheat Initiative will be supported through relevant collaboration with the agriculture department of K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University. The partnership will include knowledge exchange, technical support, and joint field activities aimed at improving wheat productivity in rural regions.

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


III. Roles and Responsibilities

- a. **Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI shall**
- Plan and deliver skill development training, career counseling, and soft skills workshops for the students of K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University.
 - Conduct aptitude mapping and career guidance sessions for interested students.
 - Provide internship opportunities to K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University students through relevant community and skill development projects.
 - Facilitate exposure visits for K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University students at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI for practical learning and field-level insights.
 - Share technical knowledge and resources related to skill development and rural livelihood enhancement.
 - Coordinate and organize free medical camps jointly with K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University, ensuring on-ground mobilization and support.
- b. **K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University shall**
- Facilitate the smooth execution of training programs, seminars, exposure visits, and other activities in collaboration with Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI.
 - Share higher education opportunities with eligible Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI students and support their admission or upskilling pathways.
 - Provide faculty members, technical experts, and academic infrastructure for resource sharing and expert sessions.
 - Arrange exposure visits for Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI students to K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University for academic and experiential learning.
 - Facilitate internship opportunities for K.M.(Krishna Mohan) University students through training participation at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI.
 - Provide support from the agriculture department for technical collaboration under initiatives such as the Better Wheat Initiative of Krishnashray Foundation.
 - Collaborate in organizing free medical camps, providing medical teams and other necessary support.

IV. Terms and Conditions

- This MoU shall remain valid for one (1) year from the Effective Date, with the option for extension upon mutual agreement in writing by both parties.
- A Joint Working Group may be formed with representatives from both institutions to monitor and evaluate implementation.
- Usage of either party's branding or logo will be done only after prior written consent.
