(Krishna Mohan) University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh as per Section 7(1)(i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the Degrees in Law and fresh approval to its Faculty of Legal Studies, K.M. (Krishna Mohan) University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh for three year LL.B(Hons.) degree course and five year BA LL.B(Hons.) integrated degree course with intake of one section of 60 students in each course for a period of one year i.e. for the academic year 2024-2025.

Sir/Ma'am,

This is to bring to your kind knowledge that the Standing Committee of Legal Education Committee of Bar Council of India by virtue of its meeting held on 28th September, 2024 considered the matter of Faculty of Legal Studies, K.M. (Krishna Mohan) University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh .

The CLE has applied for its recognition as per Section 7(1)(i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the Degrees in Law and fresh approval to its Faculty of Legal Studies, K.M. (Krishna Mohan) University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh for three year LL.B(Hons.) degree course, five year BA LL.B(Hons.) integrated degree course and five year B.Com LL.B(Hons.) integrated degree course with intake of two sections of 60 students in each course.

After consideration, recognition has been granted to K.M. (Krishna Mohan) University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh as per Section 7(1)(i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the Degrees in Law and fresh approval has also been granted to its Faculty of Legal Studies, K.M. (Krishna Mohan) University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh for three year LL.B(Hons.) degree course and five year BA LL.B(Hons.) integrated degree course with intake of one section of 60 students in each course for a period of one year i.e. for the academic year 2024-2025.



Further, the Faculty of Legal Studies is directed to construct four more classrooms of a minimum size of 750 sq ft immediately within a period of six months.

In lieu of inadequate physical and academic infrastructure as mandated under BCI Rules of Legal Education which includes shortage of core faculty members, request for 2 sections in three year LL.B(Hons.) degree course, five year BA LL.B(Hons.) integrated degree course and five year B.Com LL.B (Hons.) integrated degree course has been declined and one section for the three year LL.B(Hons.) degree course and five year BA LL.B(Hons.) integrated degree course has been approved as stated above.


Please kindly ensure, to have adequate Law, Computer, English faculty members in the ratio of 1 faculty per 40 students. Also ensure to have a qualified Librarian. Also ensure that no class room is below 750 sq feet.

If these conditions are not complied with, approval of affiliation granted may be withdrawn at any time.


You may kindly bear in mind that the Bar Council of India is the sole and supreme sanctioning authority for seats and it does not allow any supernumerary quota of seats for law degree courses, over and above the sanctioned strength of seats and whatever reservation of seats is to be done by the University under whichever quota as a rule has to be done within sanctioned strength of seats. The only supernumerary quota, as of now permitted by the Bar Council of India, is 10 percent seats in EWS quota over and above the sanctioned strength of seats allotted/approved by BCI and that too, is subject to adequate infrastructure and qualified faculty to accommodate the supernumerary seats. The same is required to be adhered to. If there is any default on such part and the same is discovered subsequently, action shall ensue which includes revocation of approval granted.

Detailed letter incorporating conditions shall be sent in due course of time.
