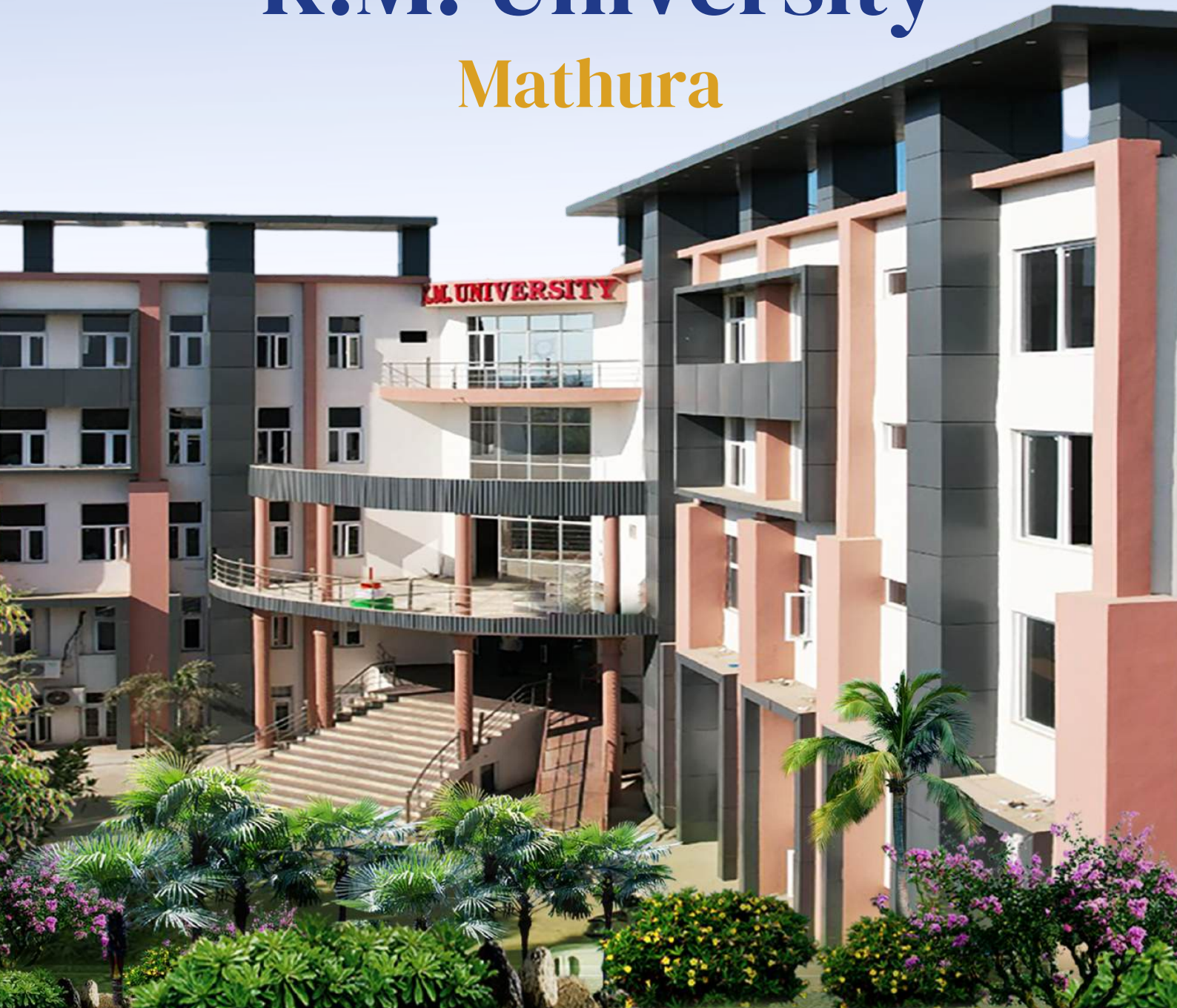

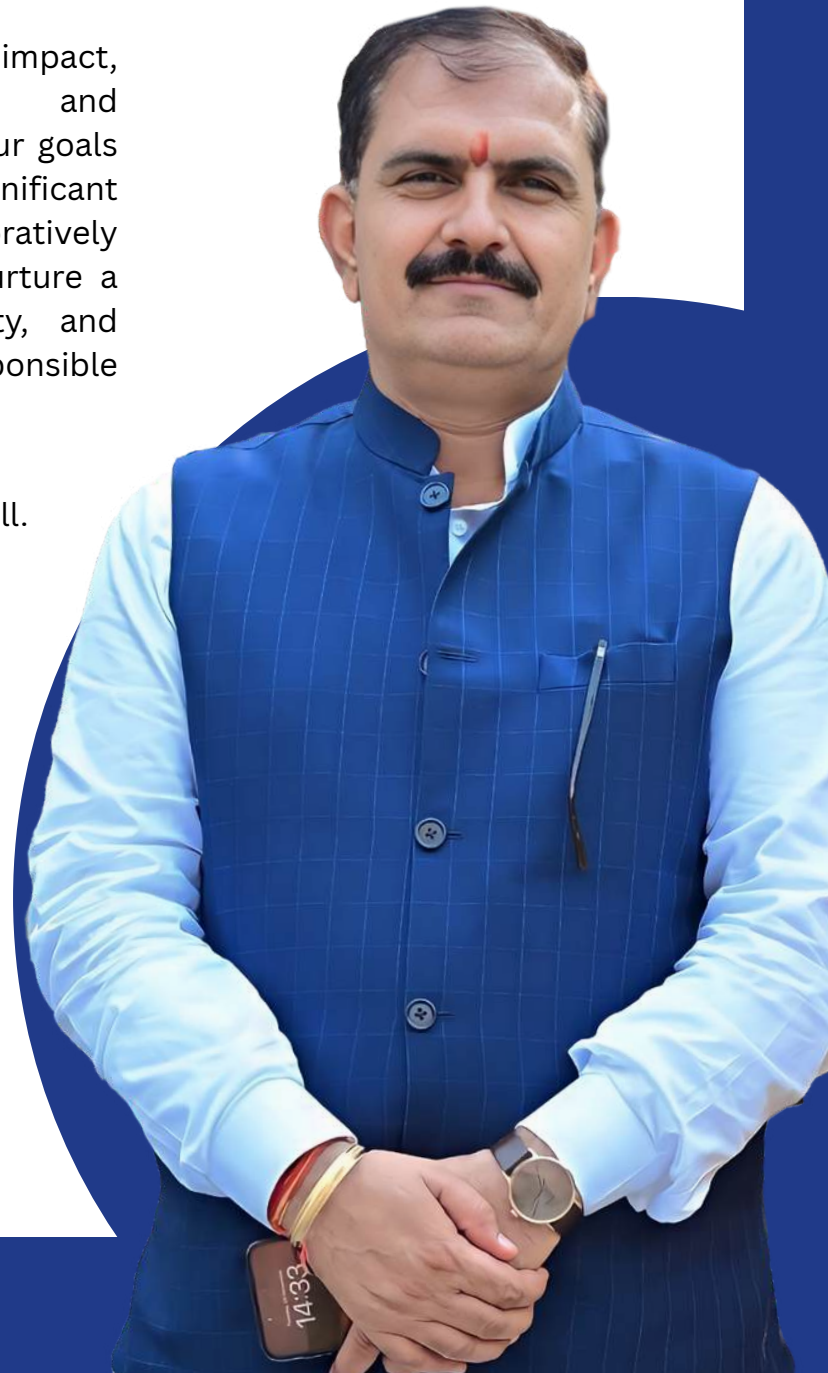

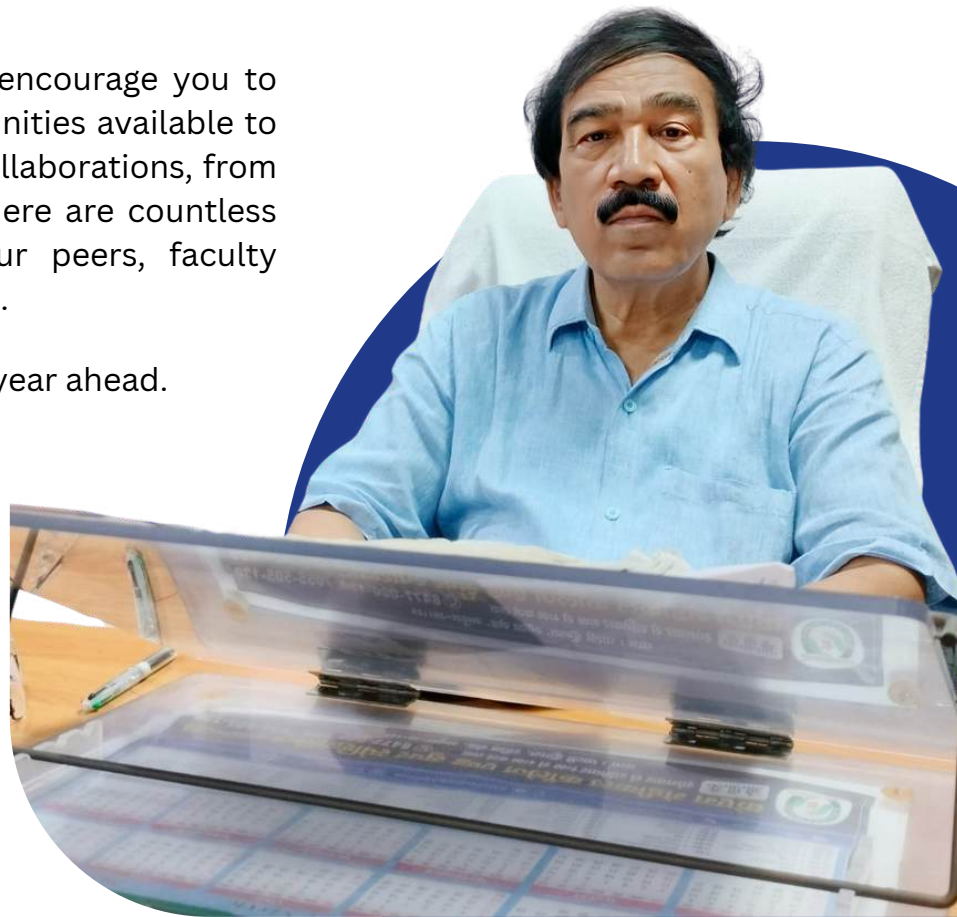

# ADMISSION PROCESS

## Eligibility Criteria

**Educational Qualification:** Applicants must meet the minimum educational qualifications for the course they are applying for (e.g., higher Secondary for undergraduate courses, bachelor's degree for postgraduate courses).

**Minimum Marks/Grade:** University usually set a minimum percentage or grade point average (GPA) requirement in the relevant subject(s) for eligibility. This could be in the form of percentage marks in the previous examination.

**Course-Specific Requirements:** Some courses may have additional requirements like specific subject qualifications (e.g., Mathematics for Engineering, Biology for Medical Sciences).

## Application Submission

**Online/Offline Application:** Candidates are required to fill out the application form, which is typically available online on the university's website or can be obtained physically.

**Documents Required:** Common documents include academic transcripts, identification proof, passport-size photographs, personal statement (if applicable), and other documents as specified by the university.

## Merit Calculation

**Academic Performance:** Admission is primarily based on merit, which is determined by the candidate's performance in relevant previous examinations.

**Weightage System:** University may assign weightages to different subjects or components, such as entrance exams or other academic achievements, to calculate the overall merit score.

**Entrance Exams (if applicable):** The University conduct own entrance exams for specific courses (e.g., engineering and management). The merit score will then include the performance in the entrance test along with academic qualifications.

## Shortlisting Candidates

Based on the merit score, a shortlist of candidates is created for further consideration.

If the university has a limited number of seats, only those who meet the minimum merit criteria are shortlisted.

## Final Admission Offer

After evaluating all documents and performance, the university will release a final list of admitted students.

Selected candidates will be notified via email, university portal, or through a public notice

**Confirmation and Payment:** Once the offer is received, candidates are required to confirm their admission by paying a confirmation fee or part of the tuition fee, as specified by the university.

**Document Verification:** The university may also verify the original documents before granting final admission.

## Orientation and Enrollment

After completing the admission formalities, the university will usually conduct an orientation session to welcome new students and provide them with necessary academic and administrative information.

Students will officially enroll in their respective courses and begin their academic journey.

Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry/ Biotechnology/Biology/Technical Vocational subject/Computer Science/Information Technology/Informatics/ Practices/ Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/ Business Studies. Obtained at least 50% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together.

### B. Tech - Computer Science and Engineering

#### Outlined in the job requirements:

Computer Science and Engineering is a field that combines computer science and engineering principles to design and develop computer systems, software, and hardware. Students will learn about computer architecture, programming languages, database management, computer networks, and software engineering.

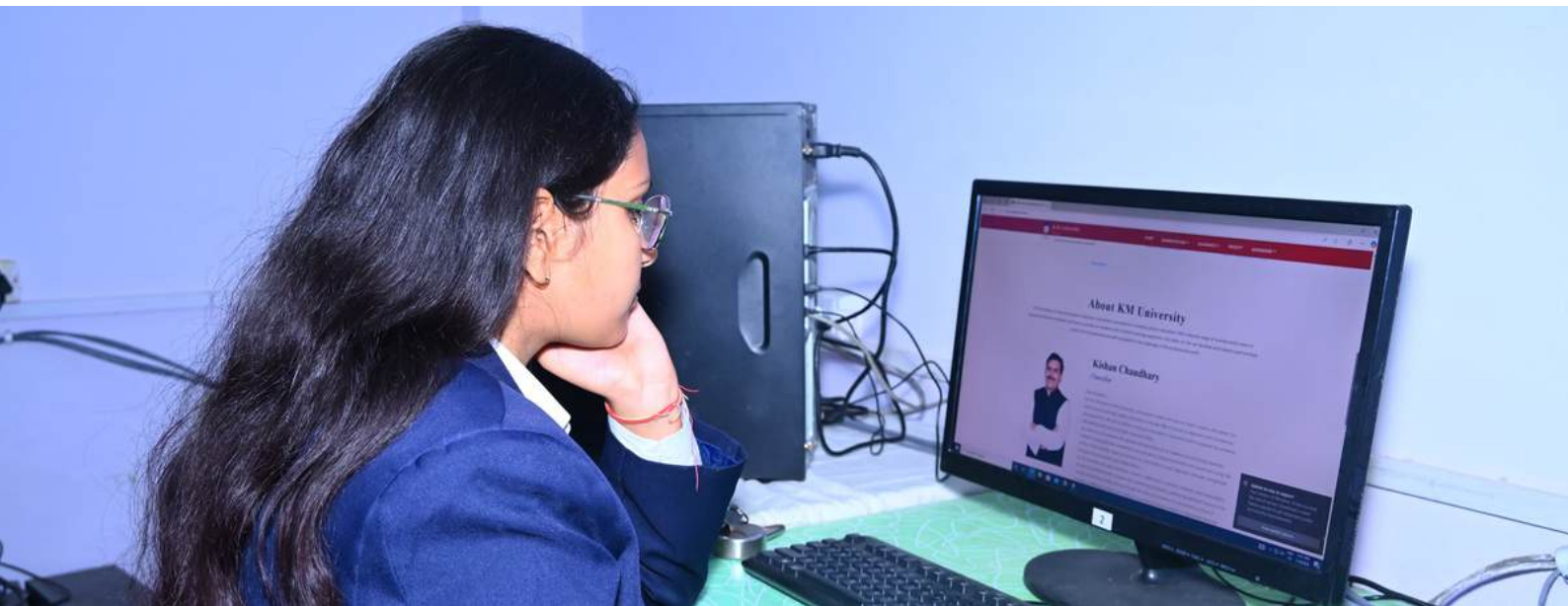

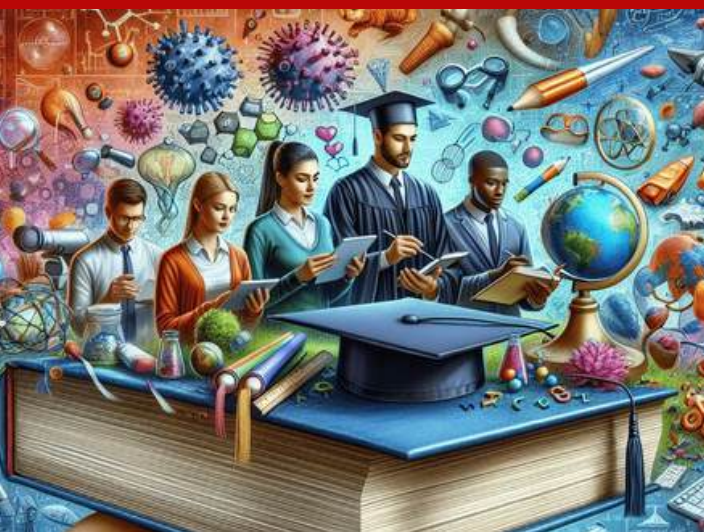

Since it is an earned research degree, those studying for a PhD are required to produce original research that expands the boundaries of knowledge, normally in the form of a dissertation, and, in some cases, defend their work before a panel of other experts in the field. The completion of a PhD is typically required for employment as a university professor, researcher, or scientist in many fields.
